

CLARK COUNTY FISCAL COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 91-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 3, PARAGRAPH 2,
OF ORDINANCE 86-2 TO SET THE LICENSE FEE AT
ONE-AND-ONE HALF PERCENT.

WHEREAS, the Clark County Fiscal Court, on May 14, 1986 gave second reading to Ordinance No. 86-2, establishing a license fee on persons employed in a trade, occupation, or profession within the County of Clark, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, Article 3, Section 2 of the Ordinance imposed a license fee of one-and-one quarter percent which was equal to the license fee then charged to those employed in the City of Winchester, and

WHEREAS, thereafter the City of Winchester has increased its license to fee to one-and-one half percent, and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Fiscal Court deems it equitable and fair that the license fee paid by those persons working outside of the corporate limits of the City of Winchester in Clark County, Kentucky, pay an amount equal to those employed within the City of Winchester,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Clark, Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:


SECTION ONE. That Article 3, Paragraph 2, of Ordinance No. 86-2 is hereby amended to read as follows: "All persons engaged in any trade, occupation, or profession within Clark County, Kentucky for themselves for profit or gain and who have as many as five or more full time employees, shall pay a license fee measured by and equal to one-and-one half percent of the net profit realized from such activity."

SECTION TWO. Except as modified in Section One above, Ordinance No. 86-2 shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1992.

Introduced for first reading by motion made by Magistrate Green, seconded by Magistrate Ramsey, and passed by majority vote

of the Clark County Fiscal Court in duly session assembled on the 13th day of November, 1991, and finally adopted after due advertisement on motion made by Magistrate Green, seconded by Magistrate Jefferson, and passed by majority vote of the Clark County Fiscal Court in duly session assembled on the 27 day of November, 1991.
